

Relocate and restore existing Picnic Pavilion east of Waikeke Road

New Granddodge (16 beds) with deck connecting to Museum (adding second makes 32 beds)

Redevelop park buildings to include new park H/Q visitor service center. Renovate / Rebuild Museum buildings

Activity area - Improved for visitor use (covered picnic tables, trail access)

Kokee Lodge - Renovated to meet park design and ADA Accessibility standards

Historic Camp activity node, to be operated and maintained by non-profit organization.

Baseyard facilities renovated to meet park design standards

Expanded leach fields

Expanded parking lot at Nu'ealolo trailhead

Trail connection to Halemanu via Faye Road.

Improved pedestrian pathway to connect cabins with Nu'ealolo Trail, CCC, and Kanaloahuluhulu Meadow.

Native plant hedge to screen cabins from Kokee Road.

Short rental cabins to be renovated and maintained by concessionaire through lease agreement.

Native plant landscape along edge of meadow

Interpretive nature loop trail

Kanaloahuluhulu Meadow as focal point

Jitney Station with shuttles to trail-head and Kalalau lookouts
